

Call for papers

To the 2nd international workshop on
“Central Europe Population History during 1st Demographic transition”

Center for Transylvanian Studies at Romanian Academy branch Cluj (represented by Academician Ioan-Aurel Pop, director), Center for Population Studies at Babeş-Bolyai University Cluj (represented by Ioan Bolovan, deputy director), and GAFP – Graz Austrian Fertility Project (represented by its head, Peter Teibenbacher) organize the 2nd International workshop on “Central Europe Population History during 1st demographic transition” (under the patronage of the International Commission of Historical Demography) at the Center for Population Studies at Babeş-Bolyai University Cluj and at the Center for Transylvanian Studies at Romanian Academy Cluj, April 8th to 9th 2011.

There will be no costs for accommodation (three nights, April 7th to 10th), lunch and dinner on April 8th and 9th and coffee in workshop breaks, Babeş-Bolyai University Cluj and the Center for Transylvanian Studies will provide all that. GAFP will support the meeting with a sum of 2.500,- € for covering traveling costs partially, concerning those only coming from outside Romania.

Therefore we are inviting you to give a paper (max. 15 min.) on one of the following topics, concerning the times of 1st Demographic transition (ca. 1850 to ca. 1930):

- 2) Religion and denomination in demography: social or cultural variables?
- 3) Migration, Fertility and Nuptiality: interdependencies
- 4) Infant mortality, Abortion and Illegitimacy: inequalities in birth and death

Please send an abstract (ca. 500 words) not later than 31st of January 2011, to Prof. Peter Teibenbacher (peter.teibenbacher@uni-graz.at) or Prof. Ioan Bolovan (bolovani@yahoo.com). The official language of the workshop will be English.

The final program will be sent out till the end of February 2011.
